More color video captures with comparison grayscale inserts. Of particular interest is the image above of the scout riding on the Panhard armored car. His black cap appears to be piped in copper brown, thus making it among the rarest pieces of headgear produced. The next four full-color images are of *Aufklärungs-Abteilung 29 (mot)* of the *29. Infanterie-Division (mot)* in 1942 prior to and during its participation in the summer offensive of Field Army group South, culminating in the disaster at Stalingrad. In the top image, a senior NCO sizes up a formation, while an officer pays final respects at the gravesite of a fallen comrade in the bottom image. All of the scouts and personnel in field-gray uniforms in these images have golden-yellow *Waffenfarbe*. **Overleaf:** Armored cars of the battalion, led by a *Sd.Kfz. 232 (Fu) (8 Rad)* and followed by a *Sd.Kfz. 222*, cross one of the innumerable waterways of the Soviet Union on an engineer bridge.
