A tailor-made leather jacket that was worn by some personnel of the 23rd of the 23rd Panzer-Aufklärungs Battalion. This panzer division was owned by the command of the 3rd Cavalry Regiment of the 23rd Panzer Division. The jacket and other uniform items, including badges and insignia, were obtained from Hain after a meeting, with the following subsequent events. On these occasions, several views were taken along with a photograph of Hain talking to a battalion officer. Hain had a stroke and died in a hospital in the summer of 1945 since the division was ordered to the West and was not to be taken to the Soviets. It was several months in the West and the personnel were released for the summer of 1945 to go back home.
