



An *Sd.Kfz. 231 (8 Rad)* is positioned to the right of an artillery prime mover as it moves past, perhaps on the occasion of yet another parade.



This *Sd.Kfz. 231 (8 Rad)* appears to be bereft of all basic-issue items. The relatively short staffs with the ball tops on the front sides of the vehicle are width indicators of the vehicle as an aid for the driver. JIM HALEY
